Students completing this class are eligible to obtain the national certification of Certified Billing and Coding Specialist from NHA.

The Certified Nurse Aid program is an 80-hour course, which includes class work with lab work and 16 hours of clinical work at a medical care facility. Students learn basic health care procedures including pulse rates, taking temperatures, respiration, blood pressure, and patient care. This program will prepare students to take the state test to become a Certified Nurse Aid.

CPR, First Aid and BLS American Heart

This CPR class is an American Heart Basic Life Support for Healthcare Providers and Heart Saver FirstAid training, including AED training. This class will cover adult, infant and child CPR/AED and first aid. Students will learn to identify when CPR is necessary, how to administrate it, the CAB's of emergency care and have the opportunity to practice on a CPR mannequin.
