Review and discuss schoolwork and homework. This includes offering assistance when needed.</li><li>2. Ensure that my child attends school on time each day and is ready to learn.</li></ol> <p><i>Show the value of learning self-control and hard work. For example:</i></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Help my child see how school learning is needed in the real world.</li><li>2. Recognize and praise my child's efforts and progress.</li></ol> <p><i>Contribute to good home/school communication. For example:</i></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Share information with school staff about unique family or child circumstances that may affect my child at school.</li><li>2. Participate in parent-teacher meetings (IEP's) and other school sponsored activities.</li><li>3. Share concerns about my child and about the school and work together with the school to resolve problems.</li></ol>
